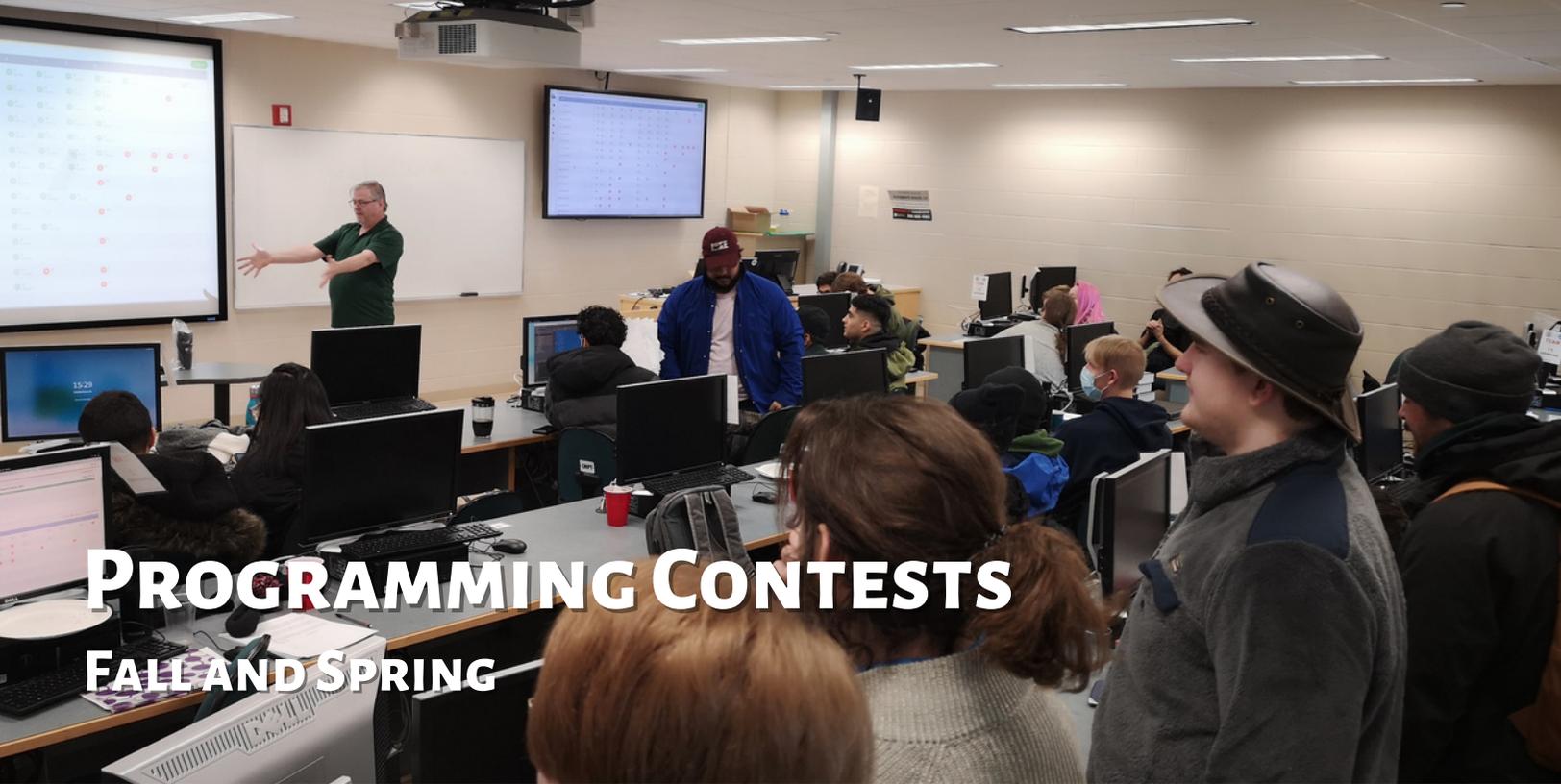
The Computer Science Graduation Banquet is hosted in collaboration with the Computer Science Student Society.
